Through her artistic and cinematographic discoveries, she decides to make in 2017 her first short film, between the marvelous tale and the war film, About Mermaids and Guns. In 2019, she directed the short film Witch, in which she offered the premises for future experiments focusing on the body and the symbolism of colors. She is currently working on her latest film, Julius & Romea (we are happy), a very free adaptation of Shakespeare's masterpiece. She just moved to Brussels, Belgium, where she works as an art decorator.
